## A good children's mattress has two sides.

Children need optimal spinal support in every stage of growth. Because depending on age and weight, the requirements placed on the mattress change. This was the reason behind the development of the K2 – an extra-special children's mattress with two different sides for lying on. When a child reaches a height of approx. 150 cm, the mattress is simply turned.

### As your child grows, the mattress grows too.

Children get their own first "big" bed between the ages of five and six. To prevent postural defects, it is essential that the mattress be tailored to the needs of children in their growth stage. The requirements for an ergonomic sleeping posture vary significantly depending on size:

#### Children up to approx. 150 cm in height



Children between 5 and 10 years old have an almost straight spine. This is not yet fully formed and requires active, firm support. The unzoned side of the K2 children's mattress provides optimum body support and remains elastic and sturdy even after years of use.

#### When a child reaches a height of approx. 150 cm, the mattress is turned.

Head | Shoulders | Lumbar region | Pelvic region | Thighs | Calves | Feet



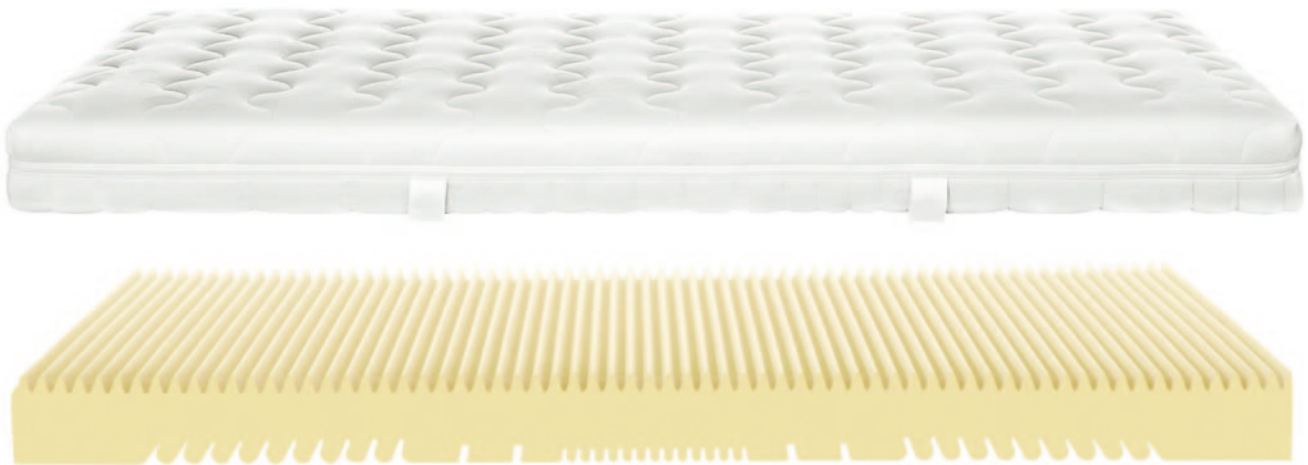
#### Children above approx. 150 cm in height

From the age of 11, the adolescent spine develops the usual double-S shape. With its 7 zones, the zoned side of the K2 children's mattress adapts perfectly to the child's body contour and supports the spine in this important growth stage. The cover is tailored to this zoning too.

# K2 Children's mattress



## Mattress cover

- Unzoned side: Quilted with 400 g/m<sup>2</sup> of breathable fiber
- Zoned side: Quilted with 300 g/m<sup>2</sup> of breathable fiber
- Durable double jersey, 54 % polyester, 46 % viscose
- All-around zipper
- Separately removable cover
- Washable up to 60 °C

## Mattress core

- 2 different core sides: Zoned and unzoned
- Elastic core made of comfort foam
- Core height approx. 13 cm
- Height with cover approx. 15 cm

The K2 children's mattress is suitable for all beds

## Points to consider when buying a children's mattress:

- ! The mattress should be tailored to the needs of children in their growth stage.
- ! The slatted frame is a decisive factor in terms of how a mattress functions. Find the perfect slatted frame in our Selecta Value range
- ! Only anti-allergy and non-toxic materials should be used.
- ! The cover should be removable and washable.
- ! The mattress should be at least 20 cm longer than the child's height.
